Fifth World Congress of the International Economic Association (Tokyo, 1977)

This fifth World Congress will be held in the Tokyo Prince Hotel from 29 August to 3 September 1977.

A Programme Committee has started work under the Chairmanship of Edmond Malinvaud (France), President of the International Economic Association, with the collaboration of Shigeto Tsuru (Japan), M. Abramovitz (USA), S. Chakravarty (India), T. Khachaturov (USSR), A. Lindbeck (Sweden), R. Matthews (UK), Z. Sadowski (Poland), R. Solow (USA), O. Sunkel (Chile), H. Uzawa (Japan), C. von Weizsäcker (FRG).

Arrangements are being made to provide special travel and accommodation for participants, including, when desired, pre- or post-Congress tours. Would-be participants will receive “News of the Congress”, i. e. periodic information on the progress of its preparation, on request to the Local Organising Committee (Chairman, Shigeto Tsuru), Tokei Kenkyu Kai, 1 - 10 Shinbashi 4-chome, Minato-ku, Tokyo 105, Japan.
